**The curriculum offer (per fortnight)**

<b>Core curriculum</b>
Maths & Numeracy double award (7hrs); English Language and Literature double award (7hrs); Science (9hrs); Welsh (5hrs + additional for Welsh first language students); Skills challenge certificate (3hrs)
<b>Tailored curriculum (Option Choices)</b>
Each student will have three option choices from an extensive range of subjects. Each option has 5 hrs per fortnight
<b>Statutory curriculum and support</b>
Students will have opportunities/experiences to continue their learning in relation to: Health & wellbeing; Relationships & Sex Education; Religion, Values & Ethics; Careers & Work-related learning. In addition, the curriculum will provide bespoke time to support pupils in developing their study & revision skills to prepare for GCSE examinations
