We would like to invite you to a parents' information evening on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2024 at 6:00 pm.

Your child is now starting their GCSE courses in school and we are aware that Bryngwyn parents are keen to support and help their children; we have therefore arranged this to provide you with information regarding GCSEs and give you an overview of the two years ahead.
