Dear Parent/Guardian,

Firstly we would like to thank you for your continued support over the Summer Term as we negotiated the busy exam periods and supported all our pupils to "give their best, to be the best". As the end of the academic year approaches, we are writing to inform you of our arrangements for the activity days at the end of term. Below is a brief outline of the organised activities that pupils can choose to take part in. There will be further, more detailed information available for each of these trips available via ParentPay. Alongside these offsite activities a varied programme of events will continue onsite for those who wish to remain in school.

Wednesday 19th July- Oakwood

As with previous years we are organising a school trip to Oakwood to reward all the hard work and positive contributions that pupils have made throughout the school year. Whilst this is an inclusive trip available to pupils, acceptance on the trip could be affected by any additional risk assessments that may be required in certain cases.

The total cost of this trip will be £25.75 per pupil, which can be paid in the usual way via ParentPay to secure your place. This non-refundable contribution of £25.75 is required to cover the cost of transport and entrance to Oakwood.

On Thursday 20th July – Pupils have a choice of 3 possible trips.

1. We are pleased to offer pupils the opportunity to join in with a **rock-climbing trip to the Dynamic Rock-Climbing Centre. The cost of the trip is £15.50** which covers the cost of the climbing activity and transport to and from the venue. There are 30 places available on the trip, and this will be on a first come, first served basis. There will be an opportunity for your child to purchase food at McDonalds if they so wish and would also require the funds to cover the cost of this.
2. Alternatively, pupils may wish to take part in a **Visit to Swansea Bay and 6 beach walk to Mumbles** along the sea front path (approx. 6 miles). Stops at Dick Barton's Chip Shop and Joe's ice cream parlour will break up the day. **A voluntary contribution of £5** is requested to cover the cost of the transport. All pupils who wish to purchase a chip shop lunch, ice cream or drinks during the day will need to bring their own money or alternatively, pupils can bring a packed lunch.
3. Pupils are also offered the opportunity to attend a **surf lesson at Llangennith beach (Gower)** provided by Progress Surf School. All equipment will be provided but will require a packed lunch for the day. Pupils will be returned to school in time for school transport. **The cost of this excursion is £37** and further details are available via Mr. M. Steadman or Mr. E. Davies

For those pupils who would prefer to remain in school a variety of activities will be provided to develop, our pupils **Courage, Curiosity, Creativity and Collaboration**.
